Words are good, but there is something better. The best cannot be explained by words. The spirit in which we act is the chief matter. Action can only be only understood and represented by the spirit. No man knows what he is doing whilst he acts well, but of doing ill we are always conscious. He who only works with symbols is a pedant, a hypocrite, or a bungler. *They are a numerous class, and associate well together. Their cant impedes the scholar, and their unvarying mediocrity afflicts the best. The instruction of the genuine artist opens the mind-for where words fail, his performance speaks. The genuine scholar learns from the known to develop the unknown, and so he gradually becomes a master.
